

## ***Thuja Golden Spire*** ('Daniellow')

### Key Features

- ✓ Rich golden yellow foliage with orange overtones.
- ✓ Tight conical growth habit.
- ✓ Trims well for hedging – can be cut back into old wood.

### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Thuja plicata</i> (Western Red Cedar).
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP 20,267. COPF open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5-8. (-20°F or -28°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Foliage selection.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	N/A.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Evergreen aromatic, rich golden yellow spray of scale-like foliage with soft orange overtones.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tight conical habit becoming columnar with maturity. 6' x 4' in 10 years. (Ultimately 20' x 5' untrimmed).
<b>Propagation:</b>	Mature winter cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best grown in full sun in moist well drained soils.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Deer resistant. Dislikes dry conditions – this may lead to foliage burn. Full sun & hot temperatures intensify the foliage color. Golden color holds well in winter temperatures.
<b>Uses:</b>	Container Specimens, Garden Specimen, Landscape Plantings. Hedging.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>3 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>12 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>

<b>Closest Variety:</b> <i>T. 'Gelderland'</i>	<b>Key Differences:</b> ✓ <b>Golden Spire</b> golden foliage <b>vs.</b> mid green foliage. ✓ <b>Golden Spire</b> slightly slower growth rate <b>vs.</b> average growth rate. ✓ <b>Golden Spire</b> pyramidal habit <b>vs.</b> dense pyramidal habit.
